Third Man Charged in October 2015 Armed Robbery



Name: Daniel Morales, 20
4100 block W. 25th Place

Charges: Two felony counts of Robbery-Armed-Other Dangerous Weapon
Issuance of Warrant (Parole Violation)

Court: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – February 24, 2016

Narrative: Daniel Morales was arrested after he was identified as one of three offenders that robbed a 27 year old male and a 26 year old female at knife point. This incident occurred on October 24, 2015 in the 1100 block of N. Lake Shore Drive at approximately 11:50 p.m. The three offenders approached the victims and demanded their property. The male victim attempted to disarm the offender wielding the knife and was stabbed in the process. The offenders then fled on foot taking several items including the victims' cell phone, wallet, credit cards and passport. The female victim was not injured. The male victim was transported to Northwestern Hospital for treatment. Two other men, Noe Mondragon and Luis Salgado-Camargo, were previously were arrested and charged in October 2015.
