Gurnee Man Charged in Douglas Shooting



Offender: Cameron White, 25
900 block of N. Crestville Ct.
Gurnee, IL

Charges: Two felony counts of Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm
Two felony counts of Attempt Murder – First Degree
Issuance of Warrant

Court: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California – February 28, 2016

Narrative: Through a joint effort with the Waukegan Police Department Gang Intelligence Unit, Chicago Gang Investigations, and Area Central Detectives, investigators were able to locate Cameron White in Waukegan, IL. White was identified as the man who shot two people on February 20, 2016; in the 2100 block of S. Wabash at approximately 2:00 a.m. White was involved in an altercation with security at a club and was expelled from the premise. A short time later, he returned and fired shots from a vehicle, striking two people. A 29 year old female was taken to Northwestern Hospital in critical condition with a gunshot wound to the forehead. A 34 year old male was also taken to Northwestern Hospital with a gun shot wound to the leg. He was listed in good condition. White was charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
