Fugitive Located and Charged in Multiple Aggravated Vehicular Hijackings



Offender: Carnell King, 19
6900 block of S. Merrill Ave.
Chicago, IL

Charges: Four felony counts of Vehicular Hijacking- Aggravated- Firearm

Court: Central Bond Court- 26th & California- March 27, 2017

Narrative: King was placed into custody after he was positively identified as the offender who committed four Aggravated Vehicular Hijackings armed with a handgun on January 10, 2017. The first incident occurred at 6:55 a.m. on the 13500 block of S. Brandon Ave. The second incident occurred at 1:28 p.m. on the 3700 block of W. 16th St. King then traveled to the 1100 block of S. Clark where a third attempt was unsuccessful after the driver disabled the keys at which time he committed the fourth hijacking on another victim at the same location at 1:31 p.m. CPD Fugitive Apprehension Unit and U.S. Marshall's located King in Atlanta, GA where he was taken into custody and extradited back to Chicago without incident where he was charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
