Roseland Man Charged in Quadruple Homicide



Offender: Lionel Parks, 29
10700 block of S. La Salle St.
Chicago, IL

Charges: Four felony counts of Murder- First Degree
Two counts of Attempt Murder- First Degree

Court: Central Bond Court- 26th & California- March 29, 2017

Narrative: Parks was placed into custody after he was positively identified as the offender who shot five victims on December 17, 2016 at 12:40 p.m. on the 100 block of W. 105th St. Parks entered a residence and forced the victims onto the floor before he began shooting. A 36-year-old male, 41-year-old female, 45-year-old male, and 19-year-old female were pronounced on the scene. An 18-year-old female sustained a gunshot wound to the head and was transported to Advocate Christ Hospital in serious condition. Parks also attempted to shoot a 22-year-old male but missed and that victim was able to escape the scene without injury. Parks was arrested and charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
