About This Crime

On June 05, 2017 at, at approximately 5:30 p.m., a 14 year old minor female victim got off the CTA bus and was on her way home walking in the 4200 block of North Cicero. The unknown offender began following the victim and was asking many questions. The victim continued walking away and the offender continued following and asked for her number, telling the victim that she can get to know him and she can come to his house. The minor victim in fear for her safety entered the McDonalds Restaurant to call her mother. The offender stayed outside the restaurant and was looking through the window gesturing with his hands for the victim to come here. The victim notified her aunt who called 911. The victim relates having seen this offender on two other occasions last year.

About the Offender

The offender is a white male, approximately 25-30 years of age, 5'06", 140 lbs., Brown eyes, and Black hair. The offender was wearing a Cubs baseball cap, White t-shirt, and Blue baggy sweatpants.
