Preliminary Statement on Police-Involved Shooting in the 1800 block of N. Monticello

CHICAGO – On November 1, 2022, at approximately 7 a.m., on-duty officers assigned to the Detached Services Unit observed a robbery in progress in the 1800 block of N. Monticello (25th District). Officers encountered multiple suspects, at least one of whom was armed, and an exchange of gunfire ensued. The suspects then fled the scene. No weapons have been recovered.

At this time, there are no reports of anyone struck by gunfire. One officer sustained minor injuries and was treated at an area hospital.

Currently, the specifics of this incident, including the comprehensive use of force investigation, are being investigated by the Civilian Office of Police Accountability with the full cooperation of the Chicago Police Department. The officer(s) involved will be placed on routine administrative duties for a period of 30 days.
