Offender Charged with Murder of Chicago Police Officer Luis M. Huesca



Offender: Xavier Tate, 22
1000 block of S. Serendipity Dr.
Aurora, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking – Aggravated – Firearm
One (1) felony count – Possession of a Stolen Firearm
Issuance of Warrant

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – May 3, 2024

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department and the U. S. Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force on May 1, 2024, in the 0-100 block of Gregory Ave. in Glendale Heights, Illinois. He was identified as the offender who shot and killed Chicago Police Officer Luis M. Huesca, 30, on April 21, 2024, in the 3100 block of W. 56th St. (8th District). The offender was placed into custody without incident and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
