Juvenile Offender Charged with Murder and Three Counts of Attempt Murder



Offender: Male juvenile, 16

Charges: One (1) felony count – Murder - First Degree
Three (3) felony counts - Attempt - Murder - First Degree

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – April 4, 2024

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by the Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force and members of the Chicago Police Department on April 2, 2024, in the 5900 block of N. Glenwood Ave. He was identified as the offender who, on February 25, 2024, at approximately 3:34 p.m., produced a firearm and opened fire, fatally shooting a 19-year-old female, and striking another 19-year-old female, a 22-year-old male, and a 20-year-old male, causing injury in the 7300 block of N. Rogers Ave. (24th District). The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
