Three Juvenile Offenders Charged with Multiple Felony Counts of Robbery



Offender #1: Male juvenile, 15

Charges: Two (2) felony counts – Robbery

Offender #2: Female juvenile, 15

Charges: Two (2) felony counts – Robbery/Victim Handicap or 60+ Years
One (1) felony count – Robbery

Offender #3: Male juvenile, 17

Charges: Two (2) felony counts – Robbery
One (1) felony count – Robbery/Victim Handicap or 60+ Years

Narrative: The three above offenders were all arrested on May 2, 2022, in the 5100 block of S. Wentworth. They were identified as offenders who robbed multiple victims on public transit over the last several weeks.

- Offender #1, a 15-year-old male, is charged with robbing a 33-year-old male on April 13, in the 600 block of S. State (1st District), and robbing a female on April 13 in the 1800 block of W. Howard (24th District).
- Offender #2, a 15-year-old female, is charged in connection to a March 21 robbery of a 74-year-old male in the 1000 block of W. Fullerton (19th District), an April 25 robbery of a 28-year-old female in the 1100 block of W. Thorndale (24th District) and an April 25 robbery of a 64-year-old male in the 900 block of W. Addison (19th District).
- Offender #3, a 17-year-old male, faces felony counts for the above-mentioned April 13 robberies, as well as the April 25 robbery in the 900 block of W. Addison.

The offenders were placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
