### Offender Charged with Multiple Felony Counts, Including Attempted Murder, Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking and Armed Robbery



**Offender:** Lennie Myles, 19  
5100 block of W. Ferdinand St., Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
Two (2) felony counts – Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Robbery - Armed with Firearm  
One (1) felony count – Attempt - Vehicular Hijacking - Aggravated - Firearm  
One (1) misdemeanor count – Resisting/Obstruct/Pc Off/Corr Emp/Frfr

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – December 5, 2023

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested on December 4, 2023, at 10:22 a.m., in the 500 block of N. Leamington. He was identified as the offender who, minutes earlier, threatened and attempted to take a vehicle at gunpoint from a 62-year-old male in the 500 block of N. Leamington (15<sup>th</sup> District). The offender is also charged in connection to additional robbery-related incidents that occurred earlier in the morning on December 4, 2023 in the 15<sup>th</sup> District:

- 7:30 a.m.: 5100 block of W. Ferdinand; 30-year-old male victim of vehicular hijacking
- 7:30 a.m.: 5100 block of W. Kinzie; 16-year-old male victim of armed robbery
- 8:20 a.m.: 5200 block of W. Ohio; 40-year-old female victim of vehicular hijacking

The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
