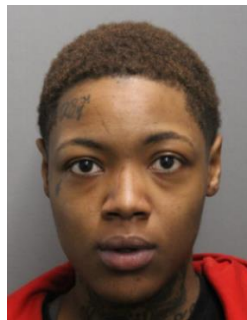

Offender Charged with Attempt Murder of 49-Year-Old Male



Offender: Makeita Thomas, 26
900 block of E. 104th St.
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count - Aggravated Battery/Great Bodily Harm
One (1) felony count - Aggravated Assault/Discharge Firearm
One (1) felony count - Reckless Discharge Firearm - Endanger

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – May 7, 2024

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by the Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force and members of the Chicago Police Department on May 6, 2024, in the 10300 block of S. Corliss Ave. She was identified as the offender who, on February 27, 2024, at approximately 11:21 a.m. shot and seriously injured a 49-year-old male victim in the 4800 block of S. Ashland Ave. (9th District). The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
