She previously served as the commanding officer of Intergovernmental Affairs within the Office of the Superintendent. Prior to this, Commander Daniel served as a sergeant in multiple police districts within the Bureau of Patrol, including the 19th (Town Hall) District, the 12th (Near West) District and the 14th (Shakespeare) District. She also served in the Mobile Strike Force, the Asset Forfeiture Unit, the Special Functions Section, the Organized Crime Division and the Auditing and Internal Control Division as a sergeant. Commander Daniel holds a Juris Doctor degree from the John Marshall Law School and a bachelor’s degree from the University of Chicago. She also attended the Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command.
