- **Narrative:** The above offender was arrested on October 7, 2023, at 3:42 p.m., in the 5400 block of S. State St. He was identified as the offender who, minutes earlier, shot and injured two victims, a 28-year-old female and a 24-year-old male, in the 7100 block of S. Cottage Grove (3rd District). The offender then fled the scene and struck a Chicago Police vehicle in the 5400 block of S. State (2nd District), causing injuries.
