Preliminary Statement on Police-Involved Shooting in the 5300 block of S. May

CHICAGO – On Thursday, August 11, 2022, at approximately 11:04 p.m., two Chicago Police officers from the Community Safety Team were responding to a Shotspotter alert in the 5300 block of S. May (009th District). While touring the location, officers observed a group of individuals at the location and approached for an investigation. Officers struggled with an armed offender at which time an officer discharged their weapon, striking the offender. The offender was transported to the University of Chicago hospital for treatment in critical condition. A weapon was recovered on scene and there were no officers injured.

Currently, the specifics of this incident, including the comprehensive use of force investigation, are being investigated by the Civilian Office of Police Accountability with the full cooperation of the Chicago Police Department. The officer(s) involved will be placed on routine administrative duties for a period of 30 days.
