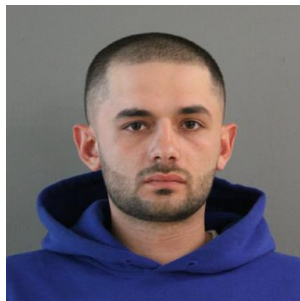

### Offender Charged with Attempted Murder of 67-Year-Old Male



**Offender:** Joey Miller, 25  
4100 block of S. Harlem  
Stickney, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree  
One (1) felony count – Home Invasion/Cause Injury  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Use Deadly Weapon

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – April 12, 2024

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Great Lakes Fugitive Task Force on April 11, 2024, in the 7100 block of W. 40th St., in Stickney, Illinois. He was identified as the offender who, on March 24, 2024, at approximately 3:10 p.m., forced entry into a residence in the 2600 block of W. 103rd St. (22nd District). Once inside he battered a 67-year-old male victim with a dangerous weapon, causing serious injury. The offender was placed into custody and charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
