**Armed Robberies - Handgun
Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to residents in the 002nd (Wentworth), 015th (Austin), 019th (Town Hall), 020th (Lincoln) and 025th (Grand Central) Districts of recent related armed robberies and aggravated vehicular hijackings

In the incidents below, the subjects approached the victims after exiting a vehicle. The victims were then robbed of their personal property at gunpoint. In two of the incidents the victims' vehicles were also stolen. In one incident the offenders forcibly accompanied the victim into the victim's residence where personal property was taken from the residence.

- 900 block of W. Sunnyside Ave on June 4, 2024 at 2:08 AM.
- 1300 block of W. Winona St on June 4, 2024 at 2:18 AM.

About the Offender:

Two to four male black subjects wearing all dark clothing and ski masks.

What you can do:

- Be aware of your surroundings
- Watch for suspicious activity or persons as you enter and exit your vehicle, at all times
- Never resist during a robbery, or pursue a fleeing assailant
- Remember any unique physical characteristics of the offender (scars, uneven gate, acne, teeth, tattoo, etc...)
- Dial 9-1-1 immediately and refrain from touching any evidence
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information, and provide to the police
