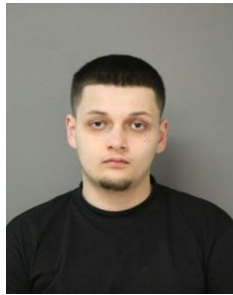

North Side Man Charged with Aggravated Battery of a Peace Officer



Offender: Jonathon Birman, 21

Charges: One (1) felony count – Agg Battery/Peace Officer
One (1) felony count – IVC – Leave Scene of Accident – Injury/Death
One (1) felony count – UUW – Weapon – Agg/Veh. Or Concealed
One (1) felony count – PCS – Possession – Poss Amt Con Sub Except (A)(D)
One (1) misdemeanor count – IVC – Flee/Attempt Elude Police
One (1) misdemeanor count – Driving on a Suspended License
One (1) misdemeanor count – Unlawful Use Cannabis/Driver
One (1) misdemeanor count – Poss Ammunition – W/O Valid FOID

Court: Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California – April 14, 2021

Narrative: Birman was arrested on April 13, 2021 in the 5900 block of W. Cornelia (16th District) at approximately 4:44 p.m. A CPD officer attempted to perform an investigatory stop of Birman, who was wanted on several prior incidents. Birman pulled the officer into his vehicle against the officer's will and then drove off at a high rate of speed. Birman crashed his vehicle into a fence within the premises, injuring the officer. Birman then attempted to flee on foot but was apprehended quickly by responding officers. Birman was placed into custody and charged accordingly. A weapon, ammunition, and narcotics were recovered inside of the vehicle. No additional information is available at this time.
