### Offender Charged with Two Counts of Armed Robbery



**Offender:** Jerry Mufid, 20  
5600 block of S. Princeton Ave.  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** Two (2) felony counts - Robbery - Armed - Other Dangerous Weapon

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – January 14, 2024

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested by members of the Chicago Police Department on January 13, 2024, at approximately 5:35 p.m. in the 0-100 block of W. Illinois St. He was identified as the offender who, an hour earlier, took property from a 32-year-old male while armed with a dangerous weapon in the 300 block of N. La Salle Dr. (18th District). The offender is also charged in connection to an armed robbery with a dangerous weapon of a 27-year-old male that occurred thirty minutes later, in the 0-100 block of E. Grand Ave. (18th District). Responding officers quickly located the offender, who was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
