Offender Charged with Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking of 37-Year-Old Male



Offender: Tamar Moses, 18

100 block of N. Waller Ave

Charges: One (1) felony count – Vehicular Hijacking - AGG - Firearm

One (1) felony count - Attempt - Robbery - Armed W/Firearm

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – April 15, 2024

Narrative: The above offender was arrested by members of the Vehicular Hijacking Task

Force on April 14, 2024, in the 100 block of N. Waller Ave. He was identified as one of the offenders who, on April 8, 2024, at approximately 11:30 p.m. took a vehicle at gunpoint from a 37-year-old male victim in the 5300 block of W. Madison St. (15th District). The offender is also charged in connection to an attempted armed robbery of a 30-year-old male that occurred thirty minutes earlier in the 100 block of N. Waller Ave. (15th District). The offender was placed into custody and
