Offender Charged with Attempted Murder, Aggravated Battery of 25-Year-Old



Offender: Allen Erenburg, 44
400 block of N. St. Louis
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One (1) felony count – Attempt - Murder - First Degree
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Use Deadly Weapon
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Battery/Great Bodily Harm
One (1) felony count – Attempt - Robbery - Armed - Other Dangerous Weapon
One (1) felony count – Attempt - Robbery

Court: Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – February 15, 2024

Narrative: The above offender was arrested on February 14, 2024, at 11:14 a.m., in the 2600 block of N Kedzie. He was identified as the offender who, less than 20 minutes earlier, stabbed a 25-year-old victim, causing serious injuries, in the 2800 block of W. Diversey (14th District). The offender also attempted to take personal property from a 28-year-old victim before fleeing. Responding officers quickly located the offender, who was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
