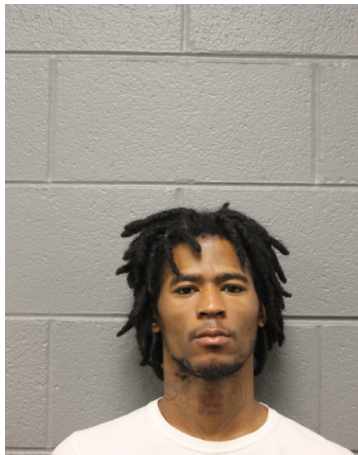

### Man Charged after Shooting at Chicago Police Officer



**Offender:** Brian Hall, 25  
4300 block of W. Gladys  
Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** One (1) felony count – AGG UUW/Loaded-No FCCA-FOID  
One (1) felony count – Reckless Disch Firearm-Endanger  
One (1) felony count – UUW - Weapon - Felon Posses/Use Firearm/Parole  
Issuance of Warrant

**Court:** Central Bond Court – 2600 S. California – October 20, 2021

**Narrative:** Brian Hall was arrested on October 17, 2021, at 11:35 p.m. in the 4200 block of W. Adams. He was identified as the individual who, minutes earlier, fired shots at an on-duty Chicago Police Officer in the 4200 block of W. Wilcox (11<sup>th</sup> District). Hall was placed into custody at the scene and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
