About This Crime

On January 20, 2015, at approximately 3:15 p.m., a 10 year-old male and an 8 year old female were walking home from school on the 3900 block of N. Spaulding Ave., when a vehicle containing two male subjects attempted to engage the children in conversation. The passenger of said vehicle requested the children to come over to his vehicle, stating he would offer them a ride home or anywhere they wish to go. After the children didn't respond, the passenger offered them candy and appeared like he was going to exit his vehicle. The children fled to their residence and the vehicle drove away.

About the Offenders

- Offender # 1 – Passenger of the vehicle
Male Hispanic, middle aged, black hair (partially bald on top), mustache, with acne or freckles on the face, wearing a beige jacket
- Offender #2 – Driver of the vehicle
Male Hispanic, middle aged, black hair, mustache, wearing a black colored hoody, with a white t-shirt underneath

About the Vehicle

- Dark green, older model sedan, 4 door, with rust towards the rear end and blue tape over one of the taillights

What You Can Do

- Call 911 to report any suspicious persons, vehicles or activity in your neighborhood.
- Walk in pairs.
- Don't talk to strangers or approach strange vehicles.
- Be aware of your surroundings and travel in well lit and populated areas.
- Be aware of this situation and alert your neighbors.
- Do not let children walk or play alone. Identify safe havens along your child's route to school and home, such as businesses or trusted neighbors.
- Find out how to start a Parent Patrol or Walking School Bus Program at your child's school.
