Wanted for Armed Robberies 004th District (South Chicago)

About this crime:

This alert gives notice to citizens of the 004th District (South Chicago) of two armed robberies reported on Beat 432 involving a similarly described offender. In each incident, the victims were approached by the offender displayed a firearm, demanding money and other property. Following the robbery, the offender was observed relocating to a maroon colored vehicle occupied by several other individuals and fleeing the scene in it. Below is additional information regarding the dates, times, and locations, of these incidents.

Incident times and locations:

- 3500 block of E. 104th Street on 17 September 2015 at approximately 12:58 a.m.
- 10400 block of S. Ewing Avenue on 17 September 2015 at approximately 1:28 a.m.

About the offender:

• Described as being a male Hispanic, approximately 18 - 21 years of age, 5'06" tall and weighing 150 lbs.

Safety tips:

- Always be aware of your surroundings
- Report suspicious activity immediately
- If you are confronted by an assailant, remain calm
- Remember any unique physical characteristics (scars, limps, acne, teeth, tattoos, etc...)
- Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide information to the police
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
- Dial 9-1-1 immediately and remain on-scene when possible
