Armed Robberies District 019 (Town Hall)

About the crime:

This alert gives notice to citizens residing in District 019 of recent armed robberies that occurred in August. In these incidents, offender(s) approached the victims, displayed a gun and demanded their property. Incident times and locations are listed below:

- 3200 block of N. Seminary Ave. on August 22nd at 11:55 pm.
- 2300 block of W. School St. on August 27th at 9:20 pm.
- 3100 block of N. Kenmore Ave. on August 30th at 12:35 am.

About the offenders:

- In the Seminary Ave incident, three offenders exit a silver 4 door sedan with black rims and body damage to the right rear quarter panel. One offender, described as a male black, 20-29 years old, short hair, medium complexion, displayed a handgun and demanded property. The other offenders were described as black males in their 20s, wearing t-shirts and baggy pants.
- In the School Street incident, the offender was described as a black male, 20-25 years old, wearing a camouflaged zip-up hooded sweatshirt and dark blue jeans. He fled in an unknown make and model vehicle driven by an unknown offender.
- In the Kenmore Ave. incident, two black males came out of the alley and demanded property at gunpoint. One was described as being 20-25 years old, 5'07", 150 lbs., wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and black pants. The second offender was described as 20-25 years old, 6'00", 160 lbs., black hooded sweatshirt and black pants.

What you can do:

- Always be aware of your surroundings
- Report suspicious activity immediately
- If you are confronted by an assailant, remain calm
- Remember any unique physical characteristics (scars, tattoos, missing teeth, etc)
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
- Dial 9-1-1 immediately and remain on scene when possible
