## **Residential Burglaries 016<sup>th</sup> District (Jefferson Park)**

### **About the crime:**

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 16<sup>th</sup> District (Jefferson Park) of several residential burglaries that have occurred in the month of October. In these incidents, unknown offender(s) have entered apartments and residences, through the front or rear doors and also windows. The offenders have taken electronics, jewelry, cash, and other miscellaneous items.

### **Incident times and locations:**

There have been several incidents that have occurred since October 09, 2015. These incidents have taken place on Beat 1623, within the boundaries of Elston to Montrose and Cicero to Central, mostly during the day and early evening hours.

- 4800 block of W. Ainslie on October 09-10, 2015 between 3:00 PM – 7:00 AM
- 5600 block of N. Elston on October 23, 2015 at 3:49 PM
- 5500 block of W. Windsor on October 26, 2015 between 7:30 AM – 8:00 PM
- 5000 block of W. Agatite on October 27, 2015 at between 7:30 AM – 6:15 PM

- Make sure all doors and windows are locked
- Pay special attention to any suspicious subjects loitering in the area
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s), including any vehicle description and license plate information, as well as direction of flight, if known.
