## Wanted for Residential Burglary 4th District (South Chicago)

### About This Crime:

This alert gives notice to residents of the South Chicago (4th) District of a dramatic increase in residential burglaries reported on Beat 421, particularly in the area extending from 76<sup>th</sup> Street south to 79<sup>th</sup> Street between Yates and Colfax. The offenders in these incidents have made forced entry into these locations through both windows and doors. Incidents have occurred at the following times and locations:

### Safety Tips:

- Notify landlord of any windows or common area doors that are in need of repair
- Ensure residents adhere to a strict policy of only granted entrance to authorized persons who attempt to "buzz into" the location.
- Notify a neighbor, friend, or relative, if you are planning to be out of town

- If you have an alarm or other security systems installed, ensure they are active or operational.
- Be aware of this situation and alert neighbors in the area about this crime.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of any suspicious people including any vehicle description and license plate information.
