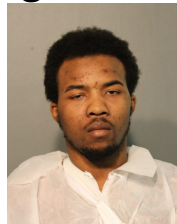

Narrative: The above offenders were arrested and charged in connection to a home invasion incident which occurred on the 3600 blk of S. Magnolia on January 9, 2016 at approximately 12:00 a.m during which offenders entered into the apartment of a 77-year-old woman, rendered the victim unconscious and stole her property and vehicle. Offenders then burglarized an additional apartment in the building. Offenders were placed into custody by 19th District officers and Area North detectives with the assistance of Illinois State Police. No additional information is available at this time.
