Wanted for Armed Robbery 004th District (South Chicago)

About This Crime:

- This alert gives notice to businesses and residents of the South Chicago (004th) District of two recent robberies that were reported on Beat 434. In each incident, the offender(s) lured a delivery driver to the area on a fictitious food order and subsequently robbed him.

About The Offenders:

- The offender(s) were described as two to three male blacks and one female black. One of the male offenders is further described heavysset. The female offender is described as being to 18 years of age, approximately 5'06"and 130 lbs.

Location of the Incidents:

- 10700 block of South Hoxie Avenue on 23 January 2016 at approximately 11:00 p.m.
- 2500 block of East 109th Street on 25 January 2016 at approximately 10: 30 p.m.

Safety Tips:

- If your business receives an order within this area, notify the police.
- Drivers should keep a minimal amount of money with them.
- Attempt to preserve all order information including the name and phone number used to place the order.
- If confronted by the armed offender, attempt to remain calm.
- Be aware of this situation and alert other business owners in the area about these crimes.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of any suspicious people including any vehicle description and license plate information.
