Wanted for Armed Robbery 22nd District (Morgan Park)

About This Crime:

This alert gives notice to residents of the Morgan Park (22nd) District, in the East Beverly neighborhood of two recent Armed Robbery incidents that occurred on February 25th & March 1st 2016. In both of these incidents, two unknown male offenders approach a male victim walking alone. The offenders either display a handgun or pretend they have one by placing their hand in their sweatshirt, and demand the victim's property. These robberies occurred between the hours of 8:00 p.m. - 11:30 p.m.

Locations of Occurrences:

- 1800 Block of W. 100th Street on February 25, 2016
- 1700 Block of W. 104th Street on March 1, 2016

About The Offenders:

The offenders were described to police as: Male, African American between the ages of 16-18, standing 5'07 tall, and weighing 160lbs. One subject had dreadlocks hairstyle. Subjects were wearing hooded sweatshirts and were armed with a silver revolver style handgun.

Safety Tips:

- Walk with a friend or group when visiting an unfamiliar neighborhood.
- Keep tracking software and security locks on your cell phone.
- Document serial numbers for your electronics and keep a record at your residence.
- Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide the information to police.
- Be aware of your surroundings and walk in well lit areas.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of any suspicious people including any vehicle description and license plate information.
