ROADSIDE SAFETY CHECK – GRAND CENTRAL (025th) DISTRICT

The Chicago Police Department will conduct a Roadside Safety Check in the Grand Central (25th) District at 4555 West North Ave. The Roadside Safety Check will commence at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, April 22, 2016 and end at 3:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 23, 2016.

During roadside safety checks, police officers slow down traffic, stop cars at regular intervals and watch for drivers who show signs of alcohol impairment and other violations as noted below.

This program is conducted year round to ensure drivers are operating their vehicles safely. This is part of an ongoing strategy to keep the city streets safe for Chicago's residents and commuters.

The Roadside Safety Check conducted in the Wentworth (002nd) District at Garfield and Perry, on April 15 – 16, 2016 resulted in the following:
