Wanted for Armed Robbery 4th District (South Chicago)

About This Crime:

This alert gives notice to residents of the South Chicago (4th) District of two recent armed robberies that occurred in the 8900 block of South Paxton Avenue. The incidents involved one to two male offenders who approached the victims and robbed them at gunpoint.

About The Offenders:

One to two male, African Americans. The first subject is described as being approximately 20 to 30 years of age, 6'00" and 180 lbs., with a medium complexion. The second subject is only described as being 5'08" with no further information.

Locations of Incidents:

- 8900 block of South Paxton Avenue on April 27, 2016 at approximately 3:50 a.m.
- 8900 block of South Paxton Avenue on April 28, 2016 at approximately 11:43 p.m.

Safety Tips:

- If confronted by the armed offender, attempt to remain calm.
- Attempt to travel with a companion and in well-lit areas.
- Notify a neighbor, friend, or relative, if you are planning to be out of town.
- Be aware of this situation and alert other business owners in the area about these crimes.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of any suspicious people including any vehicle description and license plate information.
