### Chicago Man Charged with West Pullman Shooting



**Offender:** Karl Burnett, 23  
0-100 W 112<sup>th</sup> Pl  
Chicago, IL

**Charges:** One Felony Count of Aggravated Assault/Discharge of Firearm  
One Felony Count of Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm  
Two Felony Counts of Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Felon

**Court:** Central Bond Court - 2600 S. California Avenue – September 26, 2016

**Narrative:** Burnett was arrested after he was identified as one of the men who fired shots in the 11900 block of S. Indiana Avenue on September 25, 2016 at approximately 5:57 p.m. The victim was sitting on a porch when two male offenders approached and fired shots, not striking the victim. Officers in the area heard the shots and responded to the scene. As the officers arrived they observed Burnett pick up two handguns and flee on foot. After a short foot pursuit, officers placed Burnett into custody and recovered two 9MM handguns. Burnett was identified as the person who fired shots toward the victim and was charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
