Armed Robberies 22nd District (Morgan Park)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to residents of the 22nd District (Morgan Park), in the Washington Heights neighborhood, of two recent Armed Robbery incidents that occurred on September 30th and October 2nd. In these incidents, male victims agreed to meet an unknown female through a social dating site. The victims traveled to the 9200 block of South Bishop to meet the female, but were instead met by three male subjects. The offenders then displayed handguns and demanded the victims' property.

Incident times and locations:

- 9200 block of South Bishop, Friday, September 30, 2016 at 10:00 p.m.
- 9200 block of South Bishop, Sunday, October 2, 2016 at 1:25 a.m.

About the Offender:

The offenders were described as three African American Males wearing hooded sweatshirts, armed with handguns.

What you can do:

- If meeting a stranger from the internet in person, do so at a public location, and do not meet in an area you are unfamiliar with.
- If confronted by an offender, attempt to remain clam.
- Keep tracking software and security locks on your cell phone.
- Document serial numbers for your electronics and keep a record at your residence.
- Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide the information to police.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of any suspicious people including any vehicle description and license plate information.
