Garage Burglary 22th District (Morgan Park)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to residents of the 22nd District (Morgan Park) of recent Garage Burglary incidents that occurred in the East Beverly neighborhood on beat 2212. An unknown offender has entered garages through an unlocked side door, or by forcefully opening the door with a pry tool. Once inside, the offender takes items such as bicycles, snow blowers, and gas generators from within. The offender also enters unlocked vehicles parked in the garages, taking property. These burglaries all occur during late night/early morning hours between 12:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.

Incident times and locations:

- 1600 block of West 105th Pl., Thursday, September 15, 2016 between 12:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.
- 1700 block of West 105th St., Wednesday, September 21, 2016 between 12:00 a.m. – 6:20 a.m.
- 10500 block of South Wood St., Sunday, October 2, 2016 between 12:00 a.m. – 7:25 a.m.
- 1800 block of West 105th St., Sunday, October 2, 2016 between 12:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m.

What you can do:

- Consider installing alarm system or video surveillance on your property.
- Keep records of the make/model/serial number of property.
- Be aware of the situation and alert neighbors in the area about this crime.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of any suspicious people including any vehicle description and license plate information.
- Ensure yard gates and fences are secure and garage doors are secured and any vehicle within is also locked.
- Register your bicycle online at ww.chicagopolice.org or in person at a police station.
- Notify a neighbor, friend, or relative, if you are planning to be out of town.
