Man Charged in Home Invasion and Battery of Elderly Woman in Chicago Lawn



Offender: Olajuwon Claiborne, 26
1500 block of E. 69th Place
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One Felony Count of Home Invasion- Great Bodily Harm
Two Felony Counts of Aggravated Battery- Victim 60+
One Felony Count of Robbery- Victim 60+
Two Felony Counts of Robbery

Court: Central Bond Court - 2600 S. California Avenue – December 11, 2016

Narrative: Claiborne was arrested after being identified as the offender who committed a Home Invasion on December 7, 2016 on the 5100 block of S. Long at approximately 11:52 a.m. During this incident, Claiborne entered into the home of a 94-year-old woman and battered the victim before taking her purse and fleeing the scene. The victim was transported to MacNeal Hospital for treatment. Claiborne was taken into custody on the 6900 block of S. Harper on December 9, 2016 at 1:35 p.m. and charged accordingly. During the course of the investigation, Claiborne was also identified as the offender in two separate robberies and an aggravated battery. No further information is available.
