Armed Robberies 7th District (Englewood)

About This Crime:

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 7th District (Englewood) of an increase in reported armed robberies involving similarly described offenders. In these incidents, the offenders approach their victims on foot or vehicle. A firearm is ultimately produced and the victim is robbed of their belongings.

- 6500 Block of South Marshfield Ave., Friday, December 30, @ 11:40 a.m.
- 6400 Block of South Hermitage Ave., Friday, January 06, @ 4:38 p.m.
- 1600 Block of West 61st Street, Sunday, January 22, between 2:50 p.m. 4:30 p.m.

About the Offender:

The offenders are described as being one to two males that may be accompanied by one female offender. The males are believed to be in a range of 20 to 45 years of age.

Safety Tips:

- Walk with a friend when possible
- Always be aware of your surroundings
- Report suspicious activity immediately
- If you are confronted by an assailant, remain calm
- Remember any unique physical characteristics (scars, limps, acne, teeth, tattoos, etc...)
- Retain as much information as possible as it pertains to the fare request (caller name, phone number used, address of service requested, etc)
- Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide information to the police
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
- Dial 9-1-1 immediately and remain on-scene when possible
