Armed Robberies 15th District (Austin)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice of two recent Armed Robberies of pizza delivery drivers within the boundaries of the 15th District (Austin). In these robberies, one or two offenders rob the victims at gunpoint before or after making a pizza delivery.

Incident times and locations:

- 200 block of N. Mayfield on April 5, 2017 at 10:45 p.m.
- 600 block of N. Lockwood on April 8, 2017 at 10:00 p.m.

About the Offender:

There are one or two offenders. One offender has been described as a Black male, 20-25 years old, 5'8" – 5'11" tall and weighing between 180-220 lbs. The other offender has been described as Black male, unknown age or physical description.

What you can do:

- Be aware of this crime and alert your neighbors.
- Pay special attention to any suspicious people loitering in the area.
- Maintain delivery records, including phone numbers & addresses.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s) including any vehicle description and license plate information.
