South Chicago Man charged Hit & Run Traffic Crash



Offender: Jean D. Leonard, 38
2800 block of E. 76th Street
Chicago, IL

Charges: One felony count of Leaving Scene of Accident – Injury / Death
One misdemeanor count of IVC – Failed to Give Info or Render Aid
One misdemeanor count of Uninsured Motor Veh.
One misdemeanor count of Failure to Yield to Pedestrian

Court: Central Bond Court- 26th & California- May 8, 2017

Narrative: Leonard was identified as the offender who was operating the vehicle that struck a 73-year-old male pedestrian on the 8100 block of S. Yates on May 4, 2017 at approximately 3:35 p.m. Leonard was in a 2002 Honda Civic travelling northbound on Yates when he struck the pedestrian, who was crossing the street westbound. The victim was taken to Northwestern Hospital in critical condition. Leonard turned himself in to Officers at the 3rd (Grand Crossing) District on May 6, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. and was charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
