Burglary 009th **District (Deering)**

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to citizens in the 009th District (Deering) of burglary incidents which have occurred during the months of May and June. In these incidents, offender(s) gained entry into residences and took property from therein. These incidents have occurred at various hours of the day in the general geographical locations listed below:

Incident times and locations:

- 3100 Block of South Archer Avenue on May 12, 2017 between the hours of 8:00a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- 3300 block of South Archer Avenue on May 19, 2017 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.
- 3600 block of South Wolcott Avenue on May 26, 2017 between the hours of 2:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- 3800 block of South Wood Street on June 1-2, 2017 between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m.

What you can do:

- Keep the perimeter of your property well lit
- Report suspicious activity immediately
- Keep doors and windows secured
- Immediately repair any broken windows, doors or locks
- If video surveillance is available, save and make a copy of the incident for investigating detectives.
- If you are a victim do not touch anything, call police immediately
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
