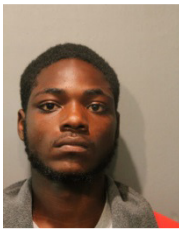

Court: 2600 S. California Ave., on July 24, 2017

Narrative: Grant and Harrington were arrested in connection with the armed robbery and shooting that occurred in the 4300 Block of S Ashland on July 21, 2017 at approx. 1:30 p.m. The armed offenders entered a Mobile store, announced a robbery and tied the male employees in the rear of the store. The offenders then fled with an undetermined amount of merchandise. While fleeing, the offenders encountered responding uniformed officers which resulted in an exchange of gunfire. A Chicago Police Officer sustained a gunshot wound to the left leg and was transported to Stroger Hospital in stable condition. A short time later, Grant and Harrington were placed into custody and charged accordingly. No further information is available at this time.
