Residential Burglaries 16th District (Jefferson Park)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to the residents of the 16th District (Jefferson Park) of recent residential burglaries that have occurred. In these incidents, unknown offender(s) have entered apartments and residences, through doors and windows, some of which were unlocked. The offenders have taken electronics, jewelry, cash, copper piping and other miscellaneous items.

Incident Times and Locations:

There have been several incidents that have occurred since August 23, 2016. These incidents have taken place on Beat 1633, within the boundaries of Belmont to Irving Park and Long to Narragansett mostly during the day and early evening hours.

- 6300 block of W. Addison on August 23-24, 2017 between 5:00 p.m.–7:30 a.m.
- 3900 block of N. Central on August 25, 2017 at 12:45 p.m.
- 6100 block of W. Cornelia on August 26, 2017 between 6:00 p.m. – 10:30 p.m.
- 5400 block of W. Eddy on September 2, 2017 at 8:17 a.m.

What you can do:

- Be aware of this crime pattern and alert your friends and family about these crimes.
- Make sure all doors and windows are locked.
- Pay special attention to any suspicious subjects loitering in the area.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s), including any vehicle description and license plate information, as well as direction of flight, if known.
