Southside Man Charged with Additional Armed Robberies While In Jail



Offender: Drane, Mishaun 18
5300 Block of South Honore St
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One Felony Count of Attempt First Degree Murder
One Felony Count of Armed Robbery
One Felony Count of Aggravated Battery
One Felony Count of Attempt Armed Robbery

Court: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California Ave. –September 20th 2017

Narrative: Drane was charged with two additional armed robberies while being detained in Cook County Jail. He is currently being held in connection to three armed robberies (please contact the State's Attorney's Office for details). The new charges were added after victims positively identified the offender as the person who robbed them at gunpoint. On August 24, 2017 the offender robbed a male, 46 years-old, at 06:20am in the 5600 block of South Springfield, the victim was not injured in this incident. Five minutes later, at 06:25am, the offender robbed and shot a 73 year-old man in the 6100 block of South Kenneth. The victim sustained a gun shot wound to the stomach and was taken to Christ Hospital in critical condition. Area Central Detectives tied this offender to Armed Robbery Pattern P17-01-22 which was issued to the media in English and Spanish. No additional information is available at this time
