Catalytic Converter Thefts 16th (Jefferson Park) District

About This Crime

This alert gives notice to residents of the 16th District (Jefferson Park) of recent catalytic converter thefts. After the catalytic converter has been removed, the vehicle will sound loud and "gravelly" when started. Catalytic converter thefts typically occur at night or very early morning hours when vehicles are parked for prolonged periods in areas accessible to thieves. Unknown offender(s) then cut and remove the catalytic converter.

What You Can Do

- Always park in well-lit areas
- Purchase a vehicle security system and make sure it is set to trigger with just the slightest motion
- Visit a trusted local muffler shop and have the converter secured to the vehicle's frame with a hardened steel welded to the frame
- Check out the different types of catalytic converter theft deterrent systems at your local auto parts store, vehicle dealer or online
- Do not confront the offenders, call 911 immediately
- Report any suspicious individuals or vehicles by calling 911 immediately
- Suspicious vehicles include vans or trucks double parked on a street with the engine running
- Note any license plates of suspicious vehicles (parked in alleys, parked illegally)
- Inform the 911 call-taker that you are calling about a suspicious person in the area where these thefts are occurring
