Burglary 9th District (Deering)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to citizens residing in the 9th District (Deering) of burglary incidents which have occurred during the month of November. In these incidents, offender(s) gain entry into residences through an unlocked door or by force and take property from therein. These incidents have occurred at various hours of the day in the general geographical locations listed below:

Incident times and locations:

3500 Block of South Damen Avenue on November 2, 2017 at 1:49PM.

1700 Block of West 35th Street during November 8-12 between 10:00AM and 11:00AM.

3100 Block of South Archer Avenue on November 11-12, 2017 between 12:00PM and 10:15AM.

3300 Block of South Seeley Avenue on November 20, 2017 at 5:30PM.

3400 Block of South Ashland Avenue on November 21, 2017 between 11:00AM and 4:00PM.

3500 Block of South Winchester Avenue on November 23, 2017 at 3:30PM.

What you can do:

- Keep the perimeter of your property well lit
- Report suspicious activity immediately
- Keep doors and windows secured
- Immediately repair any broken windows, doors or locks
- If video surveillance is available, save and make a copy of the incident for investigating detectives.
- If you are a victim do not touch anything, call police immediately
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
