ROBBERY 3rd District (Grand Crossing)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to citizens residing in the 3rd District of robbery related incidents that have occurred during the month of November. The offender is making arrangements via social media, to meet with citizens on the public way, under the pretense of selling a cell phone. When citizens arrive to complete the cash transaction, the offender brandishes a firearm and demands the victim's money.

About the Offenders:

- #1) Male, Black, approximately 17 years of age, 5'11", 250 lbs., brown eyes, black hair
- #2) Male, Black, approximately 19-22 years of age, 5'08"-6'00"

What you can do:

- Always be aware of your surroundings
- Report suspicious activity immediately
- If you are confronted by an assailant remain calm
- Remember any unique physical characteristics (scars, limp, acne, teeth, etc.)
- Never pursue a fleeing assailant, provide the information to the police
- If approached by a witness to the incident, request contact information
- Dial 9-1-1 immediately and remain on scene when possible
