Burglary-Home Invasions 16th District (Jefferson Park)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to citizens residing in the 16th District of recent burglary home invasions that have occurred. In these incidents, the offender(s) gain entry to the residences, by prying open the front door. The offender(s) also use deceptive ruses to gain entry, (examples: such as - there is a gas or water leak in the home, someone struck your vehicle, there is a fire in the home) providing any reason to get the victim's out of their homes, then another offender goes inside to take jewelry and money.

Incident Times and Locations:

- 5000 block of W. Balmoral Ave., on November 20, 2017 between 10:45 a.m.–11:00 a.m.
- 6500 block of N. Central Ave., on November 26, 2017 at 2:00 p.m.
- 6300 block of N. Ionia Ave., on November 27, 2017 at 2:10 p.m.

About the Offender:

In the November 20th incident: Offender is described as a male white, 20-35 years of age, approximately 6'00"-6'02", 200 lbs. Offender was wearing a white t-shirt.

In the November 26th incident: Offender is described as a male white 25-35 years of age, approximately 5'05"-5'08", 200 lbs. Offender was wearing a black jacket with a "NY" baseball cap.

In the November 27th incident:

Offender #1 is described as a male white Hispanic, 30 years of age, 5'08", 180 lbs., wearing a blue and red long sleeve shirt and jeans.

Offender # 2 is described as a male white Hispanic, 40-50 years of age, approximately 6'02"-6'04", 275 lbs., wearing a white short sleeve shirt and sunglasses.

Offender # 3 and # 4 are described as a male white Hispanics, 30 years of age, no further description available.

What you can do:

- Always be aware of your surroundings and lock doors and windows.
- Do not let anyone in your home to do any work unless authorized.
- Report suspicious activity immediately.
- If you are confronted by an assailant, remain calm.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s) including any vehicle description and license plate information.
- If approached by a witness to the incidents, request contact information.
