Armed Robberies Food Delivery Drivers 19th District (Town Hall)

About the Crime:

This alert gives notice to businesses in the 19th District of recent armed robberies to food delivery drivers. The victims were called to a location to deliver a pizza. When the victim arrived at the front door to make the delivery, the unknown offenders approached the victim, displayed a black handgun and demanded the victim's property.

Incident Times and Locations:

- 4200 block of N. Winchester on November 26, 2017 at 8:00 p.m.
- 4400 block of N. Greenview on November 26, 2017 at 9:04 p.m.

About the Offender:

In the Winchester incident: Offender #1 is described as a male black, 20-22 years of age, 6'00", 180 lbs. Offender was wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with black jeans. Offender # 2 described as a male black, 20-22 years of age, 5'07".

In the Greenview incident: Offender # 1 described as male black, 17-20 years of age, approximately 5'09"-5'11", 160-180 lbs. Offender was wearing a dark colored hooded sweatshirt and a black ski mask. Offender # 2 described as a male black, 17-20 years of age, 5'06"-5'08", 150-160 lbs. Offender was wearing a yellow patterned jacket, black pants and a black ski mask.

What you can do:

- Be aware of this crime and alert other Businesses.
- Pay special attention to any suspicious people loitering in the area.
- Call 911 immediately and provide a detailed description of the offender(s) including any vehicle description and license plate information as well as direction of flight, if known.
