Narrative:

Westbrooks, 51 and Eskridge, 27, were charged in connection to a shooting incident that transpired on January 2, 2018 on the 1100 block of N. Dearborn at approximately 10:30 p.m. During the incident, Westbrooks discharged a handgun and fled the scene in a white vehicle with Eskridge. Shortly after the incident, 018th District Officers located the offenders and their vehicle on the 0-100 block of W. Oak Street. Westbrooks was identified as the offender that fired the handgun and during the investigation, Eskridge made false and misleading statements. No further information at this time
