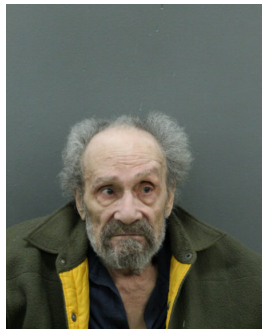

Man Charged in Far South Side Shooting



Offender: Gene Sanderlin, 88
10400 Block of South Martin Luther King Dr
Chicago, Illinois

Charges: One felony count of Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm

Court : Central Bond Court - 2600 S. California Avenue – March 22, 2018

Narrative: Sanderlin was arrested on March 20th, 2018 at approximately 8:50 p.m. for the earlier shooting of a 22-year-old woman inside of a residence at approximately 3:15 p.m. The victim was shot in the legs after a verbal altercation with the offender but was able to run to a neighbor's residence at which point the police were called. Sanderlin was observed by responding officers in the window of the residence after the shooting but refused to exit. After a standoff with police, Sanderlin eventually exited the residence and was taken into custody without incident. He was transported to a local hospital for an evaluation and then charged accordingly. The victim was treated at a local hospital where her condition stabilized. No further details are available at this time.
