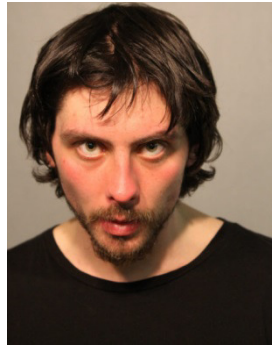

North Side Man Charged in Attempt Kidnapping of Girl



Offender: Gary L. Powell, 27

Residence: 4700 block of N. Kedvale Ave.
Chicago, IL

Charges: One felony count of Attempt – Aggravated Kidnapping/<13

Court: Central Bond Court, 2600 S. California Ave., March 28, 2018

Narrative: Gary Powell was placed in custody on March 27, 2018 at approximately 11:30 a.m., on the 3600 block of West Montrose Ave., after he was identified as the offender who followed an 11-year-old girl into a retail establishment. The incident occurred on March 27, 2018 at approximately 11:20 a.m., on the 3600 block of W. Montrose Ave. Powell followed the victim into the store and to the cash register helping her place items on the counter. Powell then insisted she accompany him out of the establishment while placing his hand around the victim. Police was summoned and responding 17th District officers placed the offender in custody. No further information is available at this time.
